Falck renews ambulance contracts in Southern California

Care Ambulance, a company in the Falck Group, has recently renewed ambulance contracts with the cities of Westminster, Fullerton and Costa Mesa in Orange County, California.

The 350,000 citizens of the three cities in Southern California will continue to see Care Ambulances on the roads over the coming years and reach Care Ambulance employees when they dial 911.

The contracts in Westminster and Costa Mesa have both been won in open

competition and will run for 5 years starting in September of 2018 whereas the Fullerton contract is a two-year extension of a contract to be sent to tender in 2020. A total of 50 employees will provide emergency services with 10 ambulances from 8 stations in the three cities.

Troy Hagen, Regional Managing Director of Falck Ambulance in California, said:

“We are happy to be able to provide continued and stable emergency services to the citizens of Westminster, Fullerton and Costa Mesa. Orange County is the home turf of Care Ambulance and we have been present here since 1969, operating in 73 cities of Orange and Los Angeles counties providing services for over 5 million citizens. We hope to continue to do so for many years to come.”
